

City of Marquette Council Meeting
Marquette City Hall
Tuesday, May 9, 2023, at 6:00PM

Mayor Weipert called the regular meeting to order at 6:00 PM with roll call and pledge of allegiance. In attendance: Gilman, Hemmer, Melver. Absent: Cornell, Schneider. Mayor opened the public hearing for the FY22/23 Budget amendment. No comments; hearing closed. Motion by Melver, second by Hemmer to approve Resolution 2023-08 adopting the FY 22/23 Budget Amendment. Roll call vote; all ayes, motion carried. Motion by Hemmer, second by Gilman to approve the consent agenda to include: agenda, 04/11/23, 04/17/23, 04/27/23 minutes, bills & claims from 04/12/23-05/09/23 of \$55,981.09, April bank reconciliations, treasurer's report, and budget report with \$235,707.06 in revenue, \$127,791.10 in expenses, UV project contract pay requests from Delta 3 for \$1,510, MC2 for \$33,380, and MZ Construction for \$37,240, and liquor license for Lazy River Festival. Roll call vote; all ayes, motion carried.

No public comments. Zoning met and recommend that Council deny the request by S.Schneider to vacate a portion of alley adjacent to his property Motion by Melver, second by Hemmer to deny the request to vacate the alley based on consideration of the zoning recommendation. Roll call vote; all ayes, motion carried. Committee reports: Police reviewed speed radar data collected on Pleasant Ridge Rd and provided call reports. DAWC reported that some field trips had been cancelled due to flooding, but Welcome Spring and Bird Friendly City events were well attended.

A DAWC part time employee has been working outside the capacity for which she was hired. Council suggested DAWC post an employment notice for the part time on-call position with a plan to hire next month. Council was updated and in support of Great Places project discussions. Motion by Melver, second by Gilman to be a Gold Sponsor for the Lazy River Festival with the 4 free tickets to be given away by a drawing. Roll call vote; all ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Gilman, second by Hemmer to approve Resolution 2023-09 to adopt a Supplement to the Code of Ordinances to compile Ordinances 421-428. Roll call vote; all ayes, motion carried. Council was not interested in the CCDG 2024 marketing campaign. Mayor reported County discussions regarding B45 are ongoing and extended a HUGE THANK YOU to everyone that helped in any way to protect the city from flooding. Motion by Hemmer, second by Melver to adjourn at 6:29PM. All ayes.
