Resolution for the City of Marquette Approval of FY 2022/2023 Maximum Property Tax Dollars

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Marquette has considered the proposed FY2022/2023 maximum property tax dollars for the affected levy total, and

WHEREAS, a notice concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars was published on January 26, 2022 as required and posted on city web site and Facebook accounts,

WHEREAS, a public hearing concerning the proposed city maximum property tax dollars was held on February 8, 2022 at 6:00PM at 102 North St. Marquette, Iowa; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Marquette, Iowa, that the maximum property tax dollars for the affected tax levies for FY2022/2023 shall not exceed \$95,587.

The Maximum Property Tax dollars requested in the total maximum levy for affected property tax levies for FY 2022/2023 represents an increase of greater than 102% from the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested for FY 2021/2022 which requires a two-thirds majority vote by City council for passage.

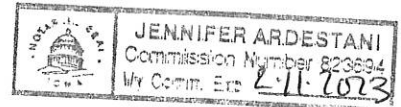
