

**City of Marquette
Regular Council Meeting
Marquette City Hall
Tuesday, January 15, 2019 @ 6:00 p.m.**

Mayor Weipert by called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM with roll call and the pledge of allegiance. Brodie- Fitzgerald, Halvorson, Ries, Soulli and Young were present. The consent agenda was reviewed. **Motion** by Brodie-Fitzgerald, second by Halvorson to approve the consent agenda to include: agenda, 12/11/18 minutes, 1/03/19 minutes. bills & claims in the amount of \$170,271.06, December financial reports showing revenue of \$92,259.50 and expenditures of \$117,808.97, and Mätt Construction contract pay request of \$45,495.50. Roll Call vote, all ayes, motion carried.

There were no public comments. Discussion was held on Pleasant Ridge Road Drainage Project and Engineering. 2 proposals were received. City Council would like to review this along with capital projects during the budget workshop before making a final decision. No action taken. Committee reports: Police Chief Robert Millin presented monthly activity report for Marquette and there will be a meet and greet with the community on January 31, 2019 from 5-7PM at the Marquette Community Room. Public Works provided an update. Wetland Centre is putting together an annual report. Copies will be distributed when it's complete. Audrey Posten was elected president of the chamber of commerce and will keep Marquette updated on events. Ries asked the Mayor to contact the railroad because more and more big trucks park under the bridge and he is concerned because of the weight restriction in that lot.

Discussion was held on current utility rates. **Motion** made by Brodie- Fitzgerald, second by Young to approve the second reading of **Ordinance 406 Updating Temporary Vacancy Language and Increasing Sanitary Sewer Rates**. Roll Call vote. Ayes: Brodie-Fitzgerald, Halvorson, Soulli, Young; Nays: Ries. Motion carried. **Motion** made by Ries, second by Young to approve **Resolution 19-01 Authorizing Office Appointments**. Roll Call vote, all ayes, motion carried. **Motion** by Brodie-Fitzgerald, second by Soulli to approve **Resolution 19-02 Approving City of Marquette Independent Account Report for Fiscal Year ended June 30, 2018**. Roll Call vote, all ayes, motion carried.

Motion by Ries, second by Brodie-Fitzgerald to have a Budget Workshop January 22, 2019 at 3:00PM at City Hall. Roll Call vote, all ayes, motion carried. Mayor had nothing to report. **Motion** by Halvorson, second by Brodie-Fitzgerald to adjourn at 6:41 PM. Roll call vote: all ayes, motion carried.
