Special Council Meeting
Marquette City Hall
Tuesday, May 28, 2019 @ 6:00 p.m.**

Mayor Weipert by called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM with roll call and pledge of allegiance. Brodie-Fitzgerald, Soulli and Young were present. Halvorson, Ries absent. Mayor opened the Public Hearing for the 2018/2019 Budget Amendment. No comments were made. Public Hearing closed. Motion by Brodie-Fitzgerald, second by Soulli to approve the agenda. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. Motion made by Young, second by Brodie-Fitzgerald to approve **Resolution 2019-09 to Approve the 2018/2019 Budget Amendment**. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. Council discussed Zoning Commission's recommendation for a building built in city limits without a permit. **Motion** made by Brodie-Fitzgerald, second by Soulli to have the owner apply for a retroactive building permit and pay a \$100.00 fine for violation of the Code of Ordinances. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried.

Motion made by Young, second by Soulli to approve **Resolution 19-10: A Resolution opposing Alliant Energy rate increase case and joining as an intervener by submitting testimony to the Iowa Utilities Board (Docket RPU-2019-0001)**. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. Depot Museum employee is unable to work due to injury. **Motion** made by Brodie-Fitzgerald, second by Young to hire Diane Benson at \$10/hr. as a temporary employee and post an ad for seasonal help for the Depot Museum. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. **Motion** by Brodie-Fitzgerald, second by Soulli to enter closed session at 6:13PM pursuant to Iowa Code 21.5 (1)(j) to discuss purchase or sale of particular real estate. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. Closed session was held. **Motion** by Soulli, second by Young to end closed session at 6:34 PM. Roll call vote: all ayes, motion carried. Public meeting opened with roll call. Fitzgerald, Soulli and Young were present. Halvorson, Ries absent. No action taken from Closed Session. Public comment: Discussion with Central State Bank on blacktopping parking lot to the east of the bank. It was suggested that they coordinate with Public Work director during the project. Motion by Soulli, second by Young to adjourn at 6:42PM. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried.
