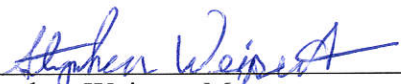
Mayor Weipert called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM with roll call and the pledge of allegiance. Brodie-Fitzgerald, Soulli, Young were present. Halvorson and Ries absent. Discussion was held on the consent agenda. **Motion** by Brodie-Fitzgerald, second by Young to approve the consent agenda to include: agenda, 1/16/2018 meeting minutes, bills & claims, & January financial reports. Roll call vote: all ayes, motion carried. Committee & department reports were presented.

Robert & Deb Vavra were present to discuss the Waterfront Use Commercial Licensing Agreement. Mr. Vavra presented his 2018 Objectives for the marina. The city attorney has reviewed the document and provided a lease termination agreement with the casino upon the sale of the property. **Motion** by Brodie-Fitzgerald, second by Soulli to approve Waterfront Use Commercial Licensing Agreement pending approval by the DNR per section 9 of the agreement. Roll call vote: all ayes, motion carried.

Discussion was held on the proposed 18/19 budget. **Motion** was made by Young, second by Soulli to approve **Resolution 18-06** Setting Time and Place for a Public Hearing for the Purpose of Soliciting Written and Oral comments on the City's Proposed Fiscal Year 2018-2018 Budget for March 13, 2018 at 6:00 PM at City Hall. Roll call vote. All ayes, motion carried.


Discussion was held on the Depot Expansion project. Based on the size of the addition and per Iowa Code, the project requires engineered prints. **Motion** by Soulli, second by Brodie-Fitzgerald to obtain 3-5 quotes for professional services required for the Depot Expansion Phase III project. Roll call vote: all ayes, motion carried.

The Mayor reported that he is trying to set up a meeting with the railroad to present ideas that inform the public during extended blocked crossings. I-76 was closed at the casino on Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 40-60 minutes. With no further business to discuss a **Motion** was made by Brodie-Fitzgerald, second by Soulli to adjourn the meeting at 6:28 p.m. Roll call vote: all ayes, motion carried.
