

**City of Marquette
Council Meeting
Marquette City Hall
Tuesday, July 13, 2021, at 6:00PM**

Mayor Weipert called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM with roll call and pledge of allegiance. In attendance: Gilman, Halvorson, Young, Schneider. Absent: Ries. Motion by Halvorson, second by Gilman to approve the consent agenda to include: agenda, 06/08/2021 minutes, bills & claims from 6/09/21-07/13/21 of \$99,728.73, June bank reconciliations, treasurer's report, and budget report with \$926,305.46 in revenue and \$969,101.51 in expenses. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. No public comment.

Committee Reports: Police provided sample data collected from Pleasant Ridge Rd from the radar sign and reviewed written call log reports. DAWC provided a written reported and noted that June was busy month with summer day camps and visitors. Chamber and Depot submitted written reports. The Wetland Centre received one application for the summer intern position. The Friends Group will reimburse the city for the payroll costs. Motion by Halvorson, second by Schneider hire Aspen Havlicek at \$10/hr for part time seasonal summer internship. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. Motion by Gilman, second by Halvorson to approve Resolution 2021-13 appointing Ryan Young to the police commission for a term that expires June 30, 2023. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. Motion by Halvorson, second by Gilman to approve Resolution 2021-14 authorizing mayor and clerk to execute documents to receive Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried.

City Hall has recently issued 2 peddlers permit for mobile food trucks and requests council consider a mobile food unit ordinance. Motion by Schneider, second by Gilman to table Mobile Food Unit Ordinance for further review by city attorney and clerk. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. Motion by Schneider, second by Gilman to approve Three Rivers prepaid propane contract for 5600 gallons @ \$1.38/gal. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. Motion by Young, second by Schneider to go into closed session at 6:25PM pursuant to Iowa Code Section 21.5 (c) to discuss strategy with counsel for matters in litigation. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. Regular meeting resumed at 6:44PM with roll call. Gilman, Halvorson, Young, Schneider. Absent: Ries. No action from closed session.

Mayor reported EV charging station is operational, currently at no charge. Fireworks were enjoyed but could have lasted longer. Solar continues to save about \$2000/mo, the Fire Department requests improvements to the garage door in Marquette, and reminded officials that fall election information is available at city hall. Motion by Gilman, second by Halvorson to adjourn at 6:51 PM. All ayes, motion carried.
