Regular Council Meeting
Marquette City Hall
Tuesday September 8, 2020 @ 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Weipert called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM with roll call and pledge of allegiance. Gilman, Schneider, Young present. Halvorson and Ries absent. Public Hearing for 20/21 Budget Amendment was opened. No comments. **Motion** by Young, second by Schneider to approve **Resolution 20-20** to approve the FY 20/21 Budget Amendment. Roll call vote: all ayes; motion carried. **Motion** by Gilman, second by Young to approve the consent agenda to include: agenda, 08/11/2020 minutes, bills & claims from 08/12/20 -9/08/20 of \$47,789.43, August bank reconciliations, treasurer's report, and budget report with \$75,209.58 in revenue and \$74,424.35 in expenses. Roll call vote: all ayes; motion carried.

No Public comment. Committee Reports: Chief Millin provided written call reports. There have been reports of spam calls in the area and reminds to not give out any personal information over the phone. Chief asks council to consider an increase to parking fines currently at \$15 that do not cover administrative costs. Chamber submitted a written report. After discussion, **motion** by Schneider, second by Young to approve estimate from Iowa Wall Sawing for \$17,850 to seal the joints on the Brown St. culvert. Roll call vote: all ayes; motion carried.

Motion by Gilman, second by Schneider to approve the second reading of **Ordinance 412** amending **Chapter 55 Animal Protection and Control**. Roll call vote: all ayes; motion carried. **Motion** by Schneider, second by Gilman to approve the second reading of **Ordinance 413** amending **Chapter 56 Dangerous and Vicious Animals**. Roll call vote: all ayes; motion carried. **Motion** by Schneider, second by Young to approve the first reading of **Ordinance 414** creating **Chapter 57 Pet Licensing**. Roll call vote: all ayes; motion carried. **Motion** by Gilman, second by Young to approve the second reading of **Ordinance 416** updating **Chapter 62 General Traffic Regulations**. Roll call vote: all ayes; motion carried. Street Finance report was presented. **Motion** by Schneider, second by Young to approve **Resolution 20-21** FY 2020 Street Finance Report. Roll call vote: all ayes; motion carried. **Motion** by Young, second by Gilman to approve **Resolution 20-22** Annual Finance Report for fiscal year ending June 30, 2020. Roll call vote: all ayes; motion carried. After discussion, motion by Schneider, second by Gilman to approve **Resolution 20-23** Solid Waste Management Comprehensive Plan. Roll call vote: all ayes; motion carried. The financial review report included recommendations that council review segregation of duties and increase water/sewer rates. After discussion, motion by Schneider, second by Young to approve **Resolution 20-24** Accountants FY2020 Financial Review Report. Roll call vote: all ayes; motion carried. Motion by Young, second by Schneider to approve **Resolution 20-25** for reimbursement of \$10,290.92 from Iowa COVID-19 Government Relief Fund. Roll call vote: all ayes; motion carried. **Motion** by Schneider, second by Gilman that Fall Clean Up be 10/17/2020. Roll call vote: all ayes; motion carried.

Mayor reported a contractor broke a water main near Gencor while installing fiber and he plans to contact the DNR to discuss regulations on empty trailers without vehicles being parked and left for the weekend in the marina lot. **Motion** was made by Gilman, second by Schneider to adjourn at 6:48 PM. All ayes, motion carried.
