

**City of Marquette
Council Meeting
Marquette City Hall
Tuesday, October 12, 2021 at 6:00PM**

Mayor Weipert called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM with roll call and pledge of allegiance. In attendance: Gilman, Schneider, Young. Absent: Halvorson, Ries. Motion by Gilman, second by Young to approve the consent agenda to include: agenda, 09/14/2021 minutes, bills & claims from 09/15/21-10/12/21 of \$91,922.97, September bank reconciliations, treasurer's report, and budget report with \$81,618.53 in revenue and \$45,163.68 in expenses, and Cobblestone's liquor license renewal. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. No public comment.

Committee Reports: Police provided monthly & quarterly call reports, and stated that DARE program has started, received 3 AED's (one for each patrol car) from a grant, and a recent shots fired report is thought to have been fireworks. Chief will have full medical release on 10/22/21 and asked if the EV charging area parking is for electric vehicles only. The city can install charging station signs. Public Works completed line striping on streets & parking areas. The storm water project at the Overlook/Halvorson property is completed. Written reports were submitted by Chamber, Wetland Centre, and Depot.

Council discussed an invoice submitted by Robyn Denning for drainage between lots 12 & 13 in the subdivision. Motion by Schneider, second by Gilman to deny request for payment for work completed on private property. After discussion, motion by Young, second by Gilman to approve Resolution 2021-19 approving the Urban Renewal Report for fiscal year ending 06/30/2021 and TIF debt certification requesting reduced payment of \$250,000 for next fiscal year. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. Motion by Young, second by Schneider to approve Resolution 2021-20 to approve the Independent Accountants Report for fiscal year ending 06/30/21. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. Motion by Gilman, second by Schneider to approve Resolution 2021-21 approving the Multi-Jurisdictional Multi- Hazard Mitigation Plan for Marquette. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried.

After discussion, Mayor read the Halloween Proclamation designating Sunday, October 31 from 4PM-7PM as "Halloween Beggars Night." Trash Clean up is scheduled for October 23, 2021. City Hall will find out cost for curb side pick for future clean up days. If nothing is received for the proposed housing project by next month, city will continue to pursue other developers. Motion by Gilman, second by Schneider to adjourn at 6:32PM. All ayes; motion carried.
