

**City of Marquette
Council Meeting
Marquette City Hall
Tuesday, November 16, 2021 at 6:00PM**

Mayor Weipert called the meeting to order at 6:21 PM with roll call and pledge of allegiance. In attendance: Halvorson, Schneider, Young. Absent: Gilman, Ries. Motion by Young, second by Schneider to approve the consent agenda to include: agenda, 10/12/2021 minutes, bills & claims from 10/13/21-11/16/2021 of \$44,200.91, October bank reconciliations, treasurer's report, and budget report with \$208,810.14 in revenue and \$87,329.73 in expenses, and Marquette Cafe liquor license renewal. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. No public comment.

Committee Reports: Written reports were submitted by Chamber, Depot Museum, Police and Wetland Centre. Pleasant Ridge Road improvements will be discussed at a later meeting when the County Engineer can be in attendance. Motion by Schneider, second by Young to table the paving proposal until spring. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried. Payment Group Services would give residents the ability to pay with a credit card. There is no fee to the city for the service and current payment options would not change. Motion by Halvorson, second by Young to approve the Payment Group Services Agreement. Roll call vote, all ayes, motion carried.

Mayor thanked newly elected Council Members for their attendance and reported that the Holiday Train will be a virtual event again this year with donations going to the Clayton County Food Bank. Information about the event will be shared on social media. Motion by Schneider, second by Young to adjourn at 6:30PM. All ayes; motion carried.
