

**City of Marquette Council Meeting  
Marquette City Hall  
Tuesday, November 8, 2022, at 6:00PM**

Mayor Weipert called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM with roll call and pledge of allegiance. In attendance: Gilman, Hemmer, Melder, Schneider. Absent Cornell. Motion by Melder, second by Schneider to approve the consent agenda to include: agenda, 10/11/2022 & 10/24/22 minutes, bills & claims from 10/12/22-11/08/2022 of \$262,864.46, October bank reconciliations, treasurer's report, and budget report with \$417,098.77 in revenue and \$132,721.26 in expenses, Delta 3 contract payment of \$2,656.00 for the UV project. Roll call vote; all ayes, motion carried.

Public Comment: none. Heidi Amundson from Norag provided information regarding their proposed use of the Roundhouse Area. After discussion, motion by Schneider, second by Gilman to table decision pending further information. Roll call vote; all ayes, motion carried. Motion by Gilman, second by Hemmer to approve Resolution 2022-23 awarding construction contract for sewer plant UV project to MZ Construction for a bid of \$45,000. Roll call vote; all ayes, motion carried. Council discussed 2<sup>nd</sup> Street Alley erosion project, no action taken pending further information.

Committee Reports: Public works has been cleaning up ash trees and getting snow equipment ready. Audrey Posten provided an update on Chamber activities. Dennis Mason provided an update on the DAWC which is working on Bird Friendly designation for Marquette. Library provided written report. Motion by Gilman, second by Melder to accept Iowa Pump Works pump bid for \$13,658.00.

Motion by Melder, second by Hemmer to approve Resolution 2022-24 to certify delinquent utility charges to property tax. Council consensus to have budget workshop meeting on December 3<sup>rd</sup>. Motion by Gilman, second by Hemmer to adjourn at 6:55PM. All ayes, motion carried.
