**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the City Council of the City of Marquette, Iowa, that the maximum property tax dollars for the affected tax levies for FY2022/2023 shall not exceed \$95,587.

The Maximum Property Tax dollars requested in the total maximum levy for affected property tax levies for FY 2022/2023 represents an increase of greater than 102% from the Maximum Property Tax dollars requested for FY 2021/2022 which requires a two-thirds majority vote by City council for passage.


